- City of Kingman Economic Development
  - KMS has been supporting the 2020 Census by handing out doorknob reminders for downtown residents to complete the census
  - MCC has purchased the Kingman Crossfit Building, anticipate 6 months for renovations to be complete (SBDC and Kingman Chamber will also be in this building)
- Support Small Business Campaign Update and information
  - The KMS board has voted to approve re-allocating \$300 from Thanksgiving fund, and also to approve allocating \$385 from the budget to purchase gift card from downtown businesses for this program. The board also voted to approve spending no more than \$100 on advertising for this program. These were votes were held via text message and were unanimous.

Announcements: Becky Fawson: The Kingman Chamber of Commerce is asking for KMS's support of Permanent Base Adjustment to the City of Kingman Budget. It limits the amount of money the city is able to spend. Under the Permanent Base Adjustment, it will not need to be approved every four years and will just automatically adjust for inflation. They would like to create a coalition of support for this. This will be on the August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 ballot. After asking TJ about the legality of supporting this, we will hold a vote via text.
