#### **General Business**

- Introductions: Greg Prudham (Board President for Kingman Farmer's Market)
- Treasurer's Report: Balance: \$9115.94
- Insurance Options: Received a cancellation notice. Discussion on letting it cancel, let it cancel or purchase the directors and officer's insurance. Beth moved that we contact Great American Insurance Company to purchase the directors and officer's insurance, Donna seconded. Motion passed.
- VISTA Update: Gina is working on video content with the office of tourism. KMS is now set up for donations through Amazon Smile. Gina is waiting to hear from Facebook regarding a donate button. - **Design Committee Update**: No update at this time.
- Palo Christi Fit Park Update: Sarah met with Gretchen Dorner (Superintendent of KUSD). The
  school district is on board with this idea. Eventually, we will go to the city to ask if they are willing
  to have Palo Christi playground for a fit park. This park will require an IGA (Inter-Governmental
  Agreement). This project will require fundraising. Donna suggested involving Historic Preservation
  Committee. There are business owners and organizations who are interested in being involved.

## Organization

• **Kingman Farmer's Market:** They have moved location to 210 E. Beale Street. Lots of help from various groups, including KMS, to help with the surface. They are looking at making several improvements. They have a capacity of 22 vendors, as of right now. They are looking at a gated/arched entry on the Beale St. side. They are looking at using the walls for art display from multiple artists. These improvements will be taking place in 30-60 days. Vendors are doing well at the new location. Lots of ideas came out about the possibility of doing something for Halloween. Donna made a motion that KMS work with the Kingman Farmers Market to have some sort of event for Halloween in downtown. Donna seconded. Motion passed.

• AZ at Work (Mary): No update available at this time. Will be placed on September agenda. The group did discuss the possibility of applying for a grant for Route 66 improvement and/or preservation. Gina will send us information regarding this grant.

- Small Business Development Center: Lisa Card reported that SBDC is fully staffed! Yeah! There are some trainings coming up. August 17: Arizona Business Compliance, August 25: Growing Your Small Business (free for right now), Basic Business Classes. Check the SBDC website for more information.
