- A RTICLE III B OARD OF D IRECTORS
- Section 7. Any action required or permitted to be taken at any in-person meeting of the Board of
- Directors may be taken without an in-person meeting, only if:
- 1) all members of the Board have been notified of the proposed action in writing (including by any
- electronic medium approved for Board actions by a separate action of the Board);
- 2) the Board has had an adequate opportunity to review, respond to, and discuss the proposed
- action;
- 3) a simple majority of the Board approves of the proposed action; and
- 4) the writing or writings setting forth the action so taken, or a summary of the substance of the
- action so taken are filed as a minute entry of the proceedings. Such action shall have the same
- force and effect as an in-person action by the Board.
- A RTICLE VIII F INANCES
- Section 1. Except as the Board of Directors may generally or in particular cases authorize the execution
- thereof in some other manner, all checks, drafts and other instruments for the payment of money and
- all instruments or transfer of securities shall be signed or executed in the name and on behalf of the
- Program by one or two (2) of any of the following people: the Program Director, the Board President,
- Vice President or Treasurer. Any instrument signed or executed by only one of these people shall then
- be reviewed and approved by another within forty-five days of the date the instrument was executed,
